As you all know, the MCC board election took place last Sunday. Our ultimate goal was to run this election process in the most transparent and fair way possible. Our brother, Dr. Asad Hossain was affirmed by court-order as the authority to conduct this election with the support of an election committee agreed upon by all. Despite significant efforts to interfere and hijack this election, Brother Asad demonstrated strength, and with the grace of Allah. he was able to conduct the election at all our centers and the results were shared with the community.

Unfortunately, as you all have heard, a <u>minority group</u> in our community defied all expectations and court instructions in their attempt to deny community members the right to vote and run in the elections by announcing a parallel election without any authority from the MCC Board or the courts.

On behalf of myself and the rest of your elected MCC board, we want to reassure you that we will not tolerate anyone who is trying to harm our community. This is a priority for us, and we will deal with such groups and individuals accordingly. We want to let you know that MCC legal counsel has initiated legal proceedings and we are scheduled to go in front of a judge next week. We are not proud of having to involve the courts. We are not doing this because we want to go to court, it is because we must do this as this minority group is forcing us to go back to the court to reaffirm the court's previous instructions.

That being said, as per the advice of MCC legal counsel, we will keep our challenge to the court of law. Regardless of what this minority group says about our sincere efforts to unify the community, we will not engage in any negative tactics or use unsanctioned or unethical ways to deal with them. This means that we will also have to refrain from sharing all the details of our legal strategy with you for now. We know you want to know more, and you deserve to know all the details. and we will release all information in due course. but we hope you will understand that we are not able to share everything at this time. Be assured, that soon we will be able to share everything with you, Insha'Allah.

Dear Brothers and Sisters, I want to finish today by letting you know that we are committed to delivering on all our promises to you, beyond dealing with this situation at hand. Since the elections, we have already met multiple times to prioritize our community's most urgent needs and to start the process of healing and unification that we all have been making du'aa for. Our newly elected brothers come with new energy, new initiatives and unquestionable passion and commitment for the betterment of the Muslim community in Calgary and Southern Alberta. We
